**Veteran Dog** (1,1). Absent

**Minor Puppy Dog** (5). **1 Adams' Barleyarch Ariat**, balanced masculine head with good eye and ears, good body short back and well knuckled feet, good coat and condition moved holding good picture and presented in very good condition. **2 Towns & Lay's Soellis Slick Rick**, also of good breed type, quality bone and nice head with good expression, in very good condition, could change places, just not as together as winner today. **3 Jones' Barleyarch Dubarry**.

**Puppy Dog** (5,1). **1 Roden's Keigame Nasrullah**, pleasing masculine head with good eye, good neck bone and body shape, good rib, topline and in very good body condition, steady and balanced on the move, has very good feet and won this on overall soundness. **2 Burford's Kavacanne Morgan You Know**, quality head with nice expression, good ears, neck and depth, good loin and well angled rear, another very good youngster in the best of condition and shows lots of promise, winner just more together today. **3 Smith's Winterwell Fowl Play**.

**Junior Dog** (5). **1 Mann's Valger Quorum**, medium sized masculine with good bone and feet, short back and moves freely with good outline, presented in first class condition, liked his overall balance, good head proportions and still needs a little more time to fill in the required complete picture. **RDCC**. **2 Wilkinson's Zarozinia Beinn An Oir**, another very nice youngster, medium sized short backed and with good bone, just slightly larger cast but also in good condition, close to winner and has a masculine balanced head, run one very close. **3 Rose's Kavacanne Morgan It Seems**.

**Graduate Dog** (2,1). **1 Rose's Kavacanne Morgan It Seems**, lovely head and good eye, good neck length, body shape, and overall breed type, in very good body condition, started to show himself off better as day went on and if was more together and up for it could have finished higher in the earlier classes.

**Post Graduate Dog** (6,1). **1 Staley's Keigame Chilli Bean at Jomeel**, masculine and medium sized, good skull, muzzle and expression, liked his overall balance and soundness, presented in very good coat and condition, lots of breed type. **2 Knowles & Glen's Wilholme I Gotta Feelin for Bessalone**, slightly stronger built overall but was balanced and in very good condition, like his bone, feet and topline too. Also with good coat of correct texture and moved with good action. **3 Pearson's Ladyhawke Sultan**.

**Limit Dog** (9,2). **1 Serpa & Griffiths' Barleyarch Trumpeter**, masculine clean cut head with good ears, good neck, bone and body shape, good depth and strong loin, well angled rear and another with well set tail and firm topline, presented in good coat and condition, quality medium balanced do. **2 Hughes' Sonnenberg Sealion**, another with lots of breed virtues and with good bone and very good feet, good depth and not too wide, short back and in very good coat and condition, also moved with purpose and was very close to winner. **3 Duncan's Kavacanne Hun Toint Retreve**.

**Open Dog** (6,1). **1 Drysdale's Ch Barleyarch Farthing at Drysika**, good head proportions, well set eyes and well placed ears hung close to head, good expression, moderate clean neck into well assembled front, good depth and strong loin well angled and muscled rear, firm short back and in very good coat and condition. He covered the ground with a well coordinated action and soundness, holding a balanced outline to win this nice class. **DCC & BOB**. **2 Lisle's Barleyarch Rolex**, another masculine quality dog with good bone, medium sized and of good depth, ever so slightly longer cast than 1 but still has much to appreciate. Also covered ground with purpose and presented in very good coat and condition, a close decision. **3 Harris' Am Grand Ch & Sh Ch Vjk-Myst Goes Like The Wind Of Barleyarch**.

**Good Citizens Dog** (2,1). **1 Adams' Barleyarch Ariat**.

**Veteran Bitch** (4,2). **1 Gardiner's Kilnrae Gretel**, 12 years and excellent condition, lovely type and shape and she covered the ground with good free action, good depth, bone and feet. **2 Staley's Jomeel Electra**, also a credit to owners, medium and with good bone, good outline and also had good head shape and expression, lots to like, paced a little when covering ground but nice shape when she got it right.

**Minor Puppy Bitch** (3). **1 Haran & Waddell's Magregor Shneeball**, lovely youngster with lots of promise, good skull and muzzle, well set eyes and good ears, moderate neck, good bone, rib and well angled rear, well set tail and holds firm outline when moving round, medium, feminine and first class presentation. **BP**. **2 Drysdale's Drysika Fast Track**, feminine and medium, good head shape and well set ears, good neck, bone and body, good coat texture and liked her very much, felt winner just had a little more rear drive and together today. **3 Angus' Soellis Silly Tilly**.

**Puppy Bitch** (1). **1 Tierney's Keigame Hustle**, feminine young lady of good type shape and also with good feet, short back and well angled rear, nice head and expression and presented in very good condition, moved freely and holds good outline.

**Junior Bitch** (6). **1 Hayes' Valger Quartz in Elfrindew**, very nice head and expression, good ears and neck, liked her body, bone and feet, well developed rear and moved with good front action and was presented in first class coat and condition. **2 Tierney's Puddledub Pour Moi**, another feminine youngster with lots of breed virtues, good bone, body shape and holds a medium balanced picture covering ground well, a little bit of a handful and not quite as finished as winner but pushed close for the top spot. **3 Tierney's Keigame Hustle**.

**Graduate Bitch** (5,1). **1 Burford's Pingarypoint Hot Topic**, medium, noble and with good head and expression, good neck, bone and body depth, strong loin and well muscled rear, moved with good front action and in very good coat and condition. **2 Edwards' Kacela Sweet Imani in Jadenco**, similar mould to winner and also not overdone but still has good quality bone and holds firm outline, nice rib and firm topline, just not as finished as winner today. **3 Gardiner's Malmelsa Flirty Fleuri**.

**Post Graduate Bitch** (6,2). **1 Roden's High High Jingle Bells at Keigame**, medium balanced and short backed, good skull muzzle and nicely fitted lips, balanced body and liked her free gait, presented in good coat and condition. **2 Cox's Cushatlaw Irresistable**, close to winner, just a little more of her but no way overdone, also balanced and with quality bone, well muscled, good type and moved with purpose holding a graceful outline. **3 Desombre's Barleyarch Springtail at Braneath**.

**Limit Bitch** (9). **1 Lockett's Winterwell Bobbie Dazzler of Fayemm**, liked her type, body shape and expression, good neck, bone and depth, not exaggerated in any way, good feet and condition, covered ground with good action and holds a nice picture. **RBCC**. **2 Rose's Kavacanne Blowin A Gale**, another with lots to like, pushed winner very close, has similar attributes to appreciate, also balanced and has a quality graceful outline, presented in first class condition. **3 Knowles & Glen's Wilholme Sharp N Smart at Bessalone**.

**Open Bitch** (8,2). **1 Haran & Waddell's Sh Ch Magregor Fluffernutter**, good width skull, correct stop, strong jaw with well fitted lips, good eye shape and ears, moderate neck, into good lay of shoulder and good depth of rib, strong loin and well angled rear, good body condition, a noble balanced exhibit who moved with good front action and holds an quality outline, excellent presentation. **BCC**. **2 Halbert's Sh Ch Valger Odessa at Marimay**, liked her bone, shape and type, good rib, body and coat, medium quality lady, feminine head and very nice expression, not quite putting it together as she could have today. **3 Harris' Sh Ch Barleyarch Piper**.

**Good Citizens Bitch** (1). **1 Gardiner's Malmelsa Flirty Fleuri**, feminine and with pleasing expression, good bone, feet and body condition, liked her breed type and overall shape, medium and in good coat, holds a steady outline on the move.
