Many thanks to all for a lovely entry, I found that coats were good. I noticed a few exhibits were a little long in loin, the standard states a medium dog, short backed standing over plenty of ground. Overall front and rear angulations were good.

Puppy Dog (5). **1 Galloway & Anderson's Alayglow Gamul Kebir.** Lovely well balanced baby, true front, ample bone and substance, good feet, sufficient depth and ribbing for age, moved out well with good topline, has a bright future. **2 Knowles & Glen's Wilholme Had A Lovely Time with Bessalone.** Masculine balanced head, true front, good bone and feet, ample depth and ribbing, strong rear, moved positively, just carrying a little too much weight today, should do well given time. **3 Angus' Barleyarch Lismore Via Calmerell.**

Junior Dog (5,1). **1 Thurm's Bryburn Bacchus.** Masculine all through, stood and moved true, good bone and feet, strong neck, lovely depth and ribbing, moved out soundly. **2 Marsh & Hoad's Winterwell Sam Spade at Kilnrae.** This boy is maturing in the right direction, everything in the right place, just needs time, moved true with purpose. **3 Cox's Ceilloch Merlot by Cushatlaw.**

Post Graduate Dog (3). **1 Jackman's Navigareamor Hardtoport.** Masculine head, good front with lovely bone, mature all through with correct depth and ribbing, strong rear, covered the ground well. **2 Sielski's Orchidstar Wotsit JW.** This young man is lovely to go over, has good balance, stood and moved true, ample bone and depth, well ribbed, just not as mature as winner, his day will come. **3 Martin's Rightig Racketeer at Lorabar.**

Limit Dog (5). **1 Trow & Jowsey's Winterwell Mr Hobbs.** Well made all through, lovely balanced head, true front, ample bone and substance, well ribbed up, strong rear, moved out well covering the ground with ease. **2 Wilkinson's Zarozinia Beinn An Oir.** Larger frame than winner, good bone, ample depth, strong rear, moved out soundly. **3 Mann's Valger Quorum JW.**

Open Dog (3). **1 Harris' Am Gr Ch & Sh Ch Vjk-Myst Goeslikethewind of Barleyarch.** My RCC winner last time I judged, he is now the finished article, everything has tightened, he presents a well balanced frame with a masculine head, lovely depth, good bone, well ribbed, strong rear, moved out with purpose, covering the ground with ease at one with handler. **DCC & BOB.** **2 Smith's Winterwell Fowl Play.** This young chap presents a well balanced picture when stacked, strong in all departments, he was on a mission today, and at times over does his movement, but still worthy of **RDCC.** **3 Malin's Sh Ch Heathermark Irish at Benrae ShCM.**

Puppy Bitch (9). A lovely class with some promising youngsters. **1 Knowles & Glen's Wilholme Agnes Brown at Bessalone.** Very feminine, lovely head, true front, ample bone and depth for age, stood and moved true, taking everything in her stride, must have a bright future. **BP.** **2 Pearson's Ladyhawke Dizzy Miss Lizzy.** Another promising baby, stands very true with everything in the right place, very feminine, once mature should do well. **3 Sielski's Orchidstar Tooty Fruitie.**

Junior Bitch (8,1). **1 Lockett's Fayemm Remember Me.** Very feminine all through, strong neck, true front with lovely bone and depth, good ribbing, moves very steady and true, handler just needs to adjust stacking position at times to show off her virtues. **2 Malin's Keigame Murphlette at Benrae.** This young girl is maturing nicely, she has balance all through, true front with ample bone, good depth and ribbing, moves out well. should do well given time. **3 Milligan's Isara Kurzhaar all Spice.**

Post Graduate Bitch (6). **1 Thompson's Redmires Bedazzled.** Good type with feminine head, true front, ample bone and depth, good substance, well ribbed up, moved soundly. **2 Garvey's Richtig Rah Rah.** Bigger frame than winner, stood and moved true, ample bone and substance. **3 Begg's Alayglow Shubra.**

Limit Bitch (7). Strong class. **1 Trow's Winterwell Inca Trail JW.** This young lady is destined for the top, at only 2 she presents a lovely picture on the stack, she is so feminine, shown in hard condition, correct body with nicely angulated rear, good bone and substance, her movement is so free and true, covering the ground well with ease. **BCC.** Pushed the dog hard for top spot. **2 Drysdale's Drysika Fast Track.** Another nice one, maturing well, has everything in the right place, moved true and steady. **3 Lindridge's Amidala Fast & Furious JW.**

Open Bitch (7,2). Good class. **1 Cox's Cushatlaw's Irresistable JW ShCM.** Feminine head and expression, true front, lovely bone and substance, good depth to a compact body showing correct length, strong rear, moved true and soundly, her day will come. **RBCC.** **2 Elrington's Barleyarch Beetle at Tequesta JW.** She is maturing nicely, well put together, ample bone and substance, stands and moves true. **3 Thurm's Sh Ch Valger Odette.**

Veteran Bitch (3,1). **1 Brown's Montalba Millie Chillum ShCM.** Now 11 years young and moves out like a youngster, very feminine, in super condition for age, covered the ground well at one with her handler. Pleased to hear she won the Veteran gundog group, well done. **2 McKinstry & Uytman's Magregor Airs 'N' Graces.** 10 yrs, stood true, ample bone and substance, in good condition just not as free on the move of winner today.
